


BOOK WEEK AT EVELYN SCOTT SCHOOL Saturday 16 August – Saturday 23 August

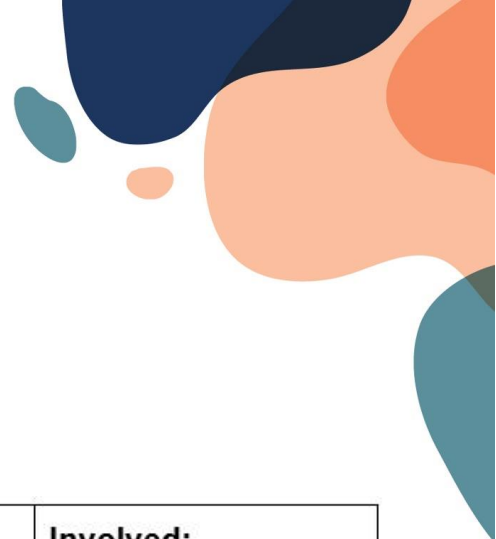
