NOTE & PAYMENT DUE:	Permission notes and payments are due back by: 13 June 2025.

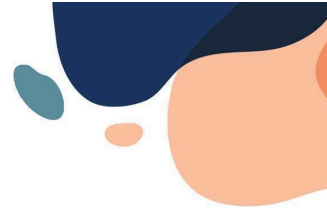

Code of Conduct and Parental Agreements:
