



## Uniform Donation Policy and Acceptable Items

### Your Contributions Matter

Thank you for your donation! Please ensure items are de-identified and in good condition, ideally freshly laundered. Garments should not need repairing (e.g., buttons missing, zips or fasteners damaged), and the school logo should not be damaged. Faded, frayed, stained, or threadbare items cannot be accepted.

Lost property overflow from the front office and out-of-school-hours-care will be donated to the second-hand uniform shop at the end of each month (labelled items will be returned to the classroom).

To support our uniform policy, we accept official ESS uniform items as listed.

### List of acceptable uniform items

- School hats with logo
- Short-sleeved polo tops with logo
- Long-sleeved polo tops with logo
- Bunji polo tops
- Uniform dresses
- School skirts
- Skorts
- Shorts
- Pants (no trackpants or leggings)
- Hoodies/pullover with logo
- Polar fleece jackets with logo
- Lined, waterproof jackets with logo
- Gloves – black or navy blue

### Other acceptable items – non-recyclable

We accept the following in excellent, undamaged condition as they cannot be recycled:

- School bags with logo
- Library bags

Families can provide damaged, non-uniform clothing to the H&M store in the Canberra Centre to save from landfill.
