

WEEK 7 LITERACY FOCUS

This week's Literacy focus has been on our **special letter of the week- letter H**. We have been thinking about how we say the sound (voices are off for this sound) and generating words which start with this sound.

We continue to **practise reading and writing Consonant-Vowel-Consonant (CVC) words** using the sounds we have already learnt (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, e, h).

If you wanted to consolidate your child's learning at home, you could:

- Play 'I spy' with a specific focus on the letters we have learnt so far (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, e, h). This helps the children to tune in to the initial sounds in words.
- Practise writing CVC words, either with a pen, chalk or even with magnetic letters. Some words you may like to practise reading and writing to consolidate our new letter sound are: hat, hen, hit, hip, him, hem.



- This game allows children to practise reading a range of CVC words.

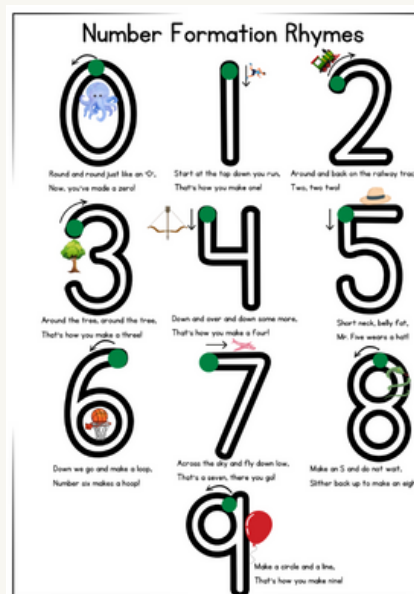
Heart words for your child to look out for when you are reading to them.
