

WEEK 2 LITERACY FOCUS

This week's Literacy focus has been on our **special letter of the week- letter b**. We have been thinking about how we say the sound (see image opposite) and generating words which start with this sound.

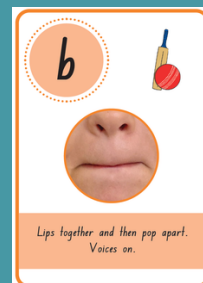
We continue to **practise reading and writing Consonant-Vowel-Consonant (CVC) words** using the sounds we have already learnt (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, e, h, r, d, o, b).

If you would like to practice at home...

- Why not make your own book with things that begin with b. Your child could write a simple sentence on each page, e.g. This is a ...
- Letter B can be a tricky one to write with the correct formation. Practice using the rhyme opposite.
- Children can sometimes get confused between the lowercase b and d. When you are reading to your child, ask them to count how many b's and d's they can find on the page. Ask them, "Are there more b's or d's on the page?"
